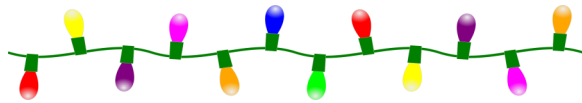


In 2021,

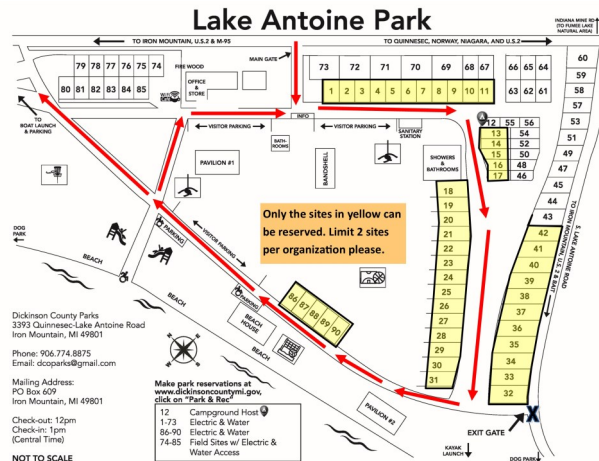

By requesting a site to decorate, I understand the following:

I/the business must provide all lights, extension cords, trees, anchors, decorations, banners, signs used at my campsite for the display dates of Saturday, November 26 – Saturday December 31, 2022. I/the business must provide my own timer.

I/the business understands the park can be blustery during snowfalls; the display should be anchored to avoid being blown away. Decorating may start Saturday, November 5 if weather allows and you/business owner know to check the display if storms pass through the area. The site decor must be completed by 5 p.m. on Saturday, November 26. Lights must be on a timer for the public viewing from 5pm - 10pm each evening November 26 through Dec. 31.

I/the business accept(s) and assume(s) full liability for any loss or damage that may occur to my lights and decorations and will not hold Lake Antoine Park Partners nor the Dickinson County Parks responsible; display will not be removed prior to the end date of December 31, 2022 at 10 p.m. My site will be cleared of all decorations prior to May 1, 2023; those left on that date will be removed and disposed of by park maintenance.
